USEFUL INFORMATION

How to get to Rome

Leonardo da Vinci airport (Fiumicino – FCO) is well connected to the city center during the day. Leonardo express is the non-stop service that connects Roma Fiumicino airport and Roma Termini, the main train station in Rome, in 30 minutes. Departures are every 15 minutes from 06:08 to 23:23. A taxi service from Terminals 1 and 3 (arrival areas) is also available. Fixed fares (each way) for some destinations, including all supplements, are as follows:

- Rome city center: € 48,00
- Tiburtina Station: € 55,00
- Ostiense Station: € 45,00

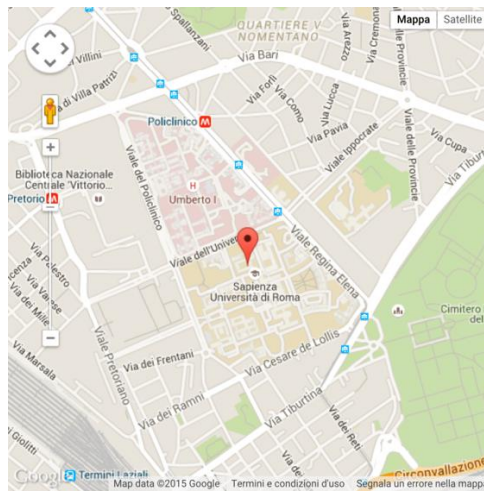
Ciampino airport (CIA) is connected by bus and train.

Since 1st March 2019 Trenitalia Ciampino Airlink service (combined train and bus) is available from the entrance of the airport (€ 2,70 is the total fare). The bus connection, which leaves every 20 minutes, takes passengers to Ciampino train Station with no intermediate stops; from there you can continue your journey to Termini by train.

Taxi fixed fares (each way) for some destinations, including all supplements, are as follows:

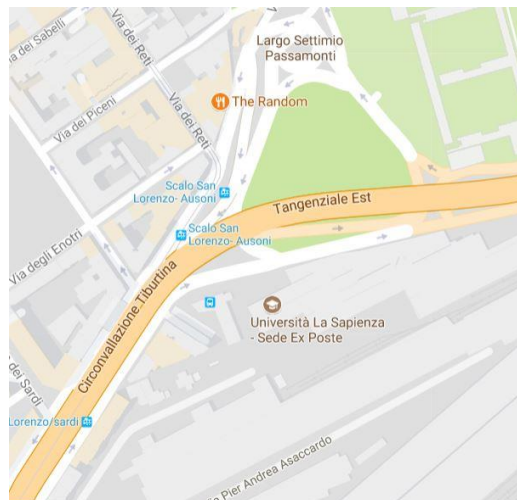
- Rome city center: € 30,00
- Ostiense Station: € 30,00
- Tiburtina Station: € 35,00

Getting to Sapienza University



Facoltà di Lettere e Filosofia is located in the main Campus (Città universitaria). Piazzale Aldo Moro 5 (00185, Roma) is the main Campus entrance, the other entrances are in Viale dell'Università, Viale Regina Elena and Via Cesare de Lollis.

The University campus can be reached by bus (lines: 310, 71, 163, 492), by tram (lines: 3 and 19) and by underground - B line (Policlinico stop).



Marco Polo is located in Circonvallazione Tiburtina 4 00185, Rome (S. Lorenzo area).

- From the main Campus (Città universitaria): tram 3 or 19 to Scalo S. Lorenzo/Sardi.
- From Roma Termini: bus 50 to Casilina/P.le Labicano or tram 5 or 14 to Labicano/Porta Maggiore; then tram 3 or 19 to Scalo S. Lorenzo/Sardi.

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Taxi companies:

Although the cheapest way to catch a cab is by waiting at the official taxi stops on the streets of Rome, it is also possible to book a taxi on the telephone.

These are some of the taxi companies in the city:

- Radio Taxi: 06-3570.
- Pronto Taxi: 06-6645.
- Other companies: 06-5551, 06-4994, 06-4157.

- Official taxi rates to and from both airports: To get to and from Fiumicino Airport and Ciampino Airport will always cost you the same. The journey to/ from Fiumicino costs € 48 and Ciampino, € 30. These prices are valid for up to four passengers and their suitcases. Refuse to pay if you are charged an extra.
- The rates from Termini railway station to the city centre should cost between € 8 and € 15. If you can, it is always a good idea to check the route on Google Maps before you get in the taxi so you have an idea of how long it takes.
- Choose the correct type of taxi: The first thing to do as not to get swindled is to make sure the taxi you take is correctly identified. All taxis in Rome are white, with a taxi roof sign and a taximeter visible at the front of the car. Hail cabs that have a telephone number written on the sides of the vehicle, which means that they work for a taxi company.
- If you have any problem, write down the taxi's license plate number (it is always at the back of the front seats) and call the taxi company.
- If at any point you think you are being swindled, don't let the taxi driver intimidate you and call the Carabinieri. Additionally, it is always a good idea to ask for a receipt and complain to the taxi company.
